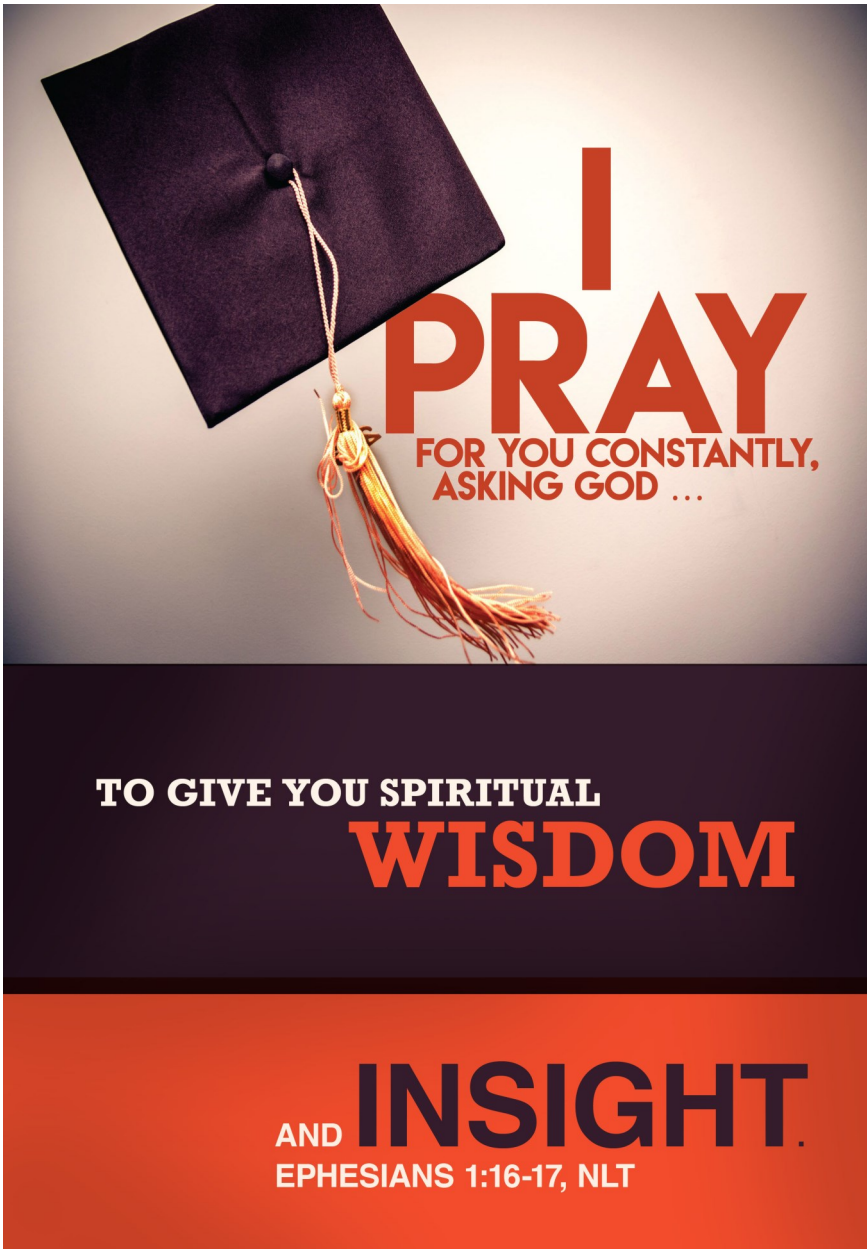

Psalm 47

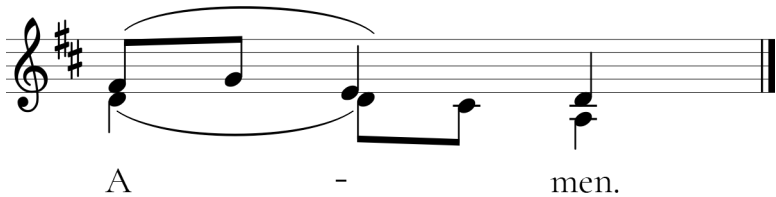

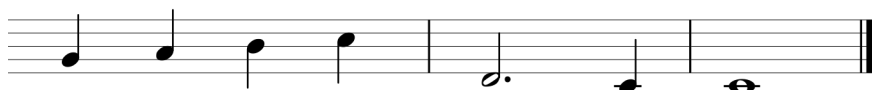

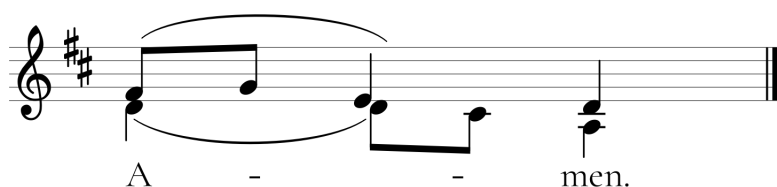

Proverbs 2:1-8 My son, if you receive my words, And

your ear to wisdom, *And* apply your heart to understand-
ing; ³ Yes, if you cry out for discernment, *And* lift up your
voice for understanding, ⁴ If you seek her as silver, And
search for her as *for* hidden treasures; ⁵ Then you will un-
derstand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge
of God. ⁶ For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth
come knowledge and understanding; ⁷ He stores up sound

1 Corinthians 3:11-20 ¹¹ For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² Now if anyone builds on this foundation *with* gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, ¹³ each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. ¹⁴ If anyone's work which he has built on *it* endures, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire. ¹⁶ Do you not know that you are the temple of God and *that* the Spirit of God dwells in you? ¹⁷ If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which *temple* you are. ¹⁸ Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. ¹⁹ For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their *own* craftiness"; ²⁰ and again, "The LORD knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile."

Children's Sermon

#427:1-4 How Firm a Foundation

SERMON

Luke 19:12-27 ¹² Therefore He said: "A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom and to return. ¹³ "So he called ten of his servants, delivered to them ten minas, and said to them, 'Do business till I come.' ¹⁴ "But his citizens hated him, and sent a delegation

after him, saying, 'We will not have this *man* to reign over us.' ¹⁵ "And so it was that when he returned, having received the kingdom, he then commanded these servants, to whom he had given the money, to be called to him, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading. ¹⁶ "Then came the first, saying, 'Master, your mina has earned ten minas.' ¹⁷ "And he said to him, 'Well *done*, good servant; because you were faithful in a very little, have authority over ten cities.' ¹⁸ "And the second came, saying, 'Master, your mina has earned five minas.' ¹⁹ "Likewise he said to him, 'You also be over five cities.' ²⁰ "Then another came, saying, 'Master, here is your mina, which I have kept put away in a handkerchief. ²¹ 'For I feared you, because you are an austere man. You collect what you did not deposit, and reap what you did not sow.' ²² "And he said to him, 'Out of your own mouth I will judge you, *you* wicked servant. You knew that I was an austere man, collecting what I did not deposit and reaping what I did not sow. ²³ 'Why then did you not put my money in the bank, that at my coming I might have collected it with interest?' ²⁴ "And he said to those who stood by, 'Take the mina from him, and give *it* to him who has ten minas.' ²⁵ ("But they said to him, 'Master, he has ten minas.') ²⁶ 'For I say to you,

that to everyone who has will be given; and from him who does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him. ²⁷ 'But bring here those enemies of mine, who did not want me to reign over them, and slay *them* before me.'"

The Lord Has Blessed You

The main point of this parable is the gifts of the nobleman, not the works of the slaves. He gives and his gifts bring blessings. Those who despise his gifts receive nothing from him. The greatest of his gifts is Christ.

 way from Your pres - ence. Take not Your Ho - ly
 Spir-it from me. Restore to me the joy of Your sal-
 va - tion. Up - hold with Your Spir-it free.

CALL NEWS

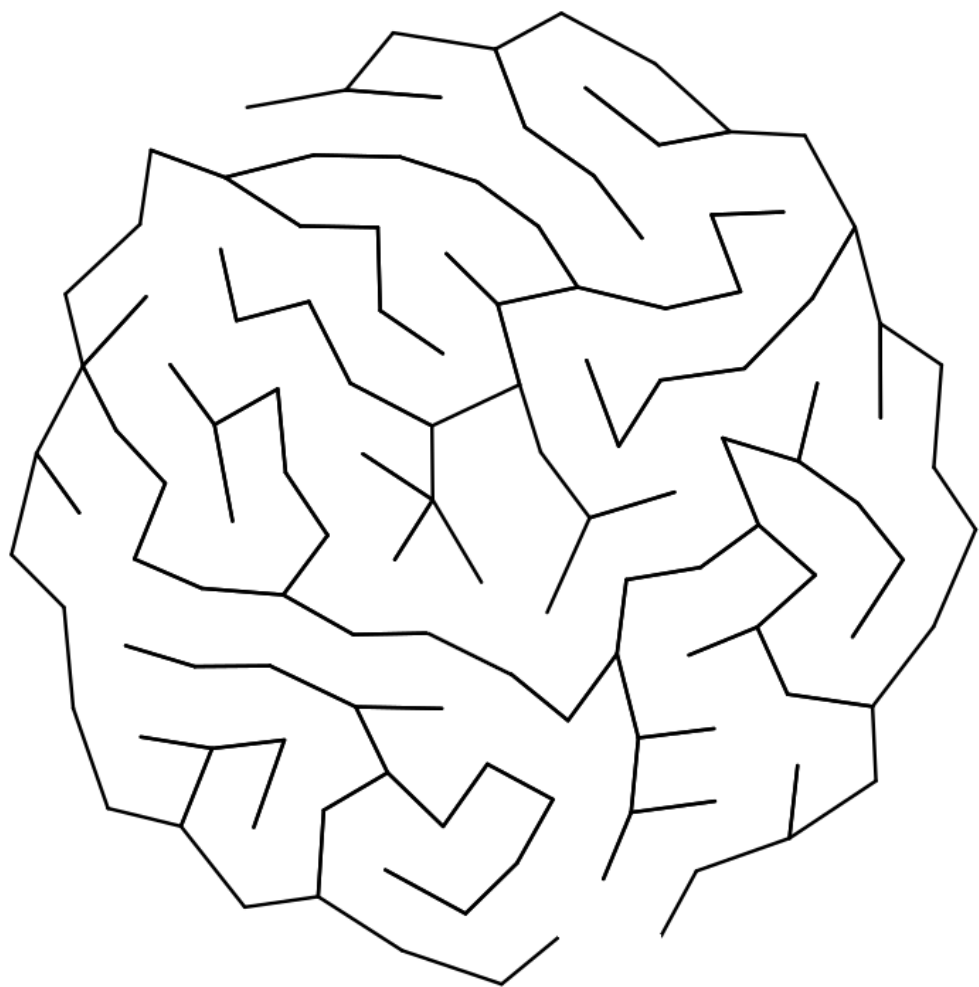
