
p In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.



CONFESSION OF SINS

THE WORD


Galatians 5:13-25 ¹³ For you, brethren, have been called to liberty; only do not use liberty as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. ¹⁴ For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this: "You shall love your neighbor as yourself." ¹⁵ But if you bite and devour one another, beware lest you be consumed by one another! ¹⁶ I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. ¹⁹ Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,²³

gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. ²⁴ And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

Luke 9:51-62 ⁵¹ Now it came to pass, when the time had come for Him to be received up, that He steadfastly set His face to go to Jerusalem, ⁵² and sent messengers before His face. And as they went, they entered a village of the Samaritans, to prepare for Him. 53 But they did not receive Him, because His face was set for the journey to Jerusalem. ⁵⁴ And when His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them, just as Elijah did?" 55 But He turned and rebuked them, and said, "You do not know what manner of spirit you are of. ⁵⁶ "For the Son of Man did not come to destroy men's lives but to save them." And they went to another village. 57 Now it happened as they journeyed on the road, that someone said to Him, "Lord, I will follow You wherever You go." 58 And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay His

head." ⁵⁹ Then He said to another, "Follow Me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father." ⁶⁰ Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God." ⁶¹ And another also said, "Lord, I will follow You, but let me first go *and* bid them farewell who are at my house." ⁶² But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

p Blessed are they who hear the Word of God and keep it!



ATHANASIAN CREED – PART THREE

Note: In this context the word catholic means universal. Thus, when we talk about the catholic faith we mean the one and only true faith which God has given to us in His word.

p But it is also necessary for everlasting salvation that one faithfully believe the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

c Therefore, it is the right faith that we believe and confess that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is at the same time both God and man.

p He is God, begotten from the substance of the Father before all ages; and He is man, born from the substance of His mother in this age:

c perfect God and perfect man, composed of a rational soul and human flesh;

p equal to the Father with respect to His divinity, less than the Father with respect to His humanity.

c Although He is God and man, He is not two, but one Christ:

p one, however, not by the conversion of the divinity into flesh but by the assumption of the humanity into God; c one altogether, not by confusion of substance, but by unity of person.

p For as the rational soul and flesh is one man, so God and man is one Christ,

c who suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose again from the dead, ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father, from whence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

p At His coming all people will rise again with their bodies and give an account concerning their own deeds.

c And those who have done good will enter into eternal life, and those who have done evil into eternal fire. Amen

#341:1-4 Crown Him with Many Crowns

SERMON

I Samuel 3:10-21 ¹⁰ Now the LORD came and stood and called as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears." ¹¹ Then the LORD said to Samuel: "Behold, I will do something in Is-

rael at which both ears of everyone who hears it will tingle. ¹² "In that day I will perform against Eli all that I have spoken concerning his house, from beginning to end.¹³ "For I have told him that I will judge his house forever for the iniquity which he knows, because his sons made themselves vile, and he did not restrain them. ¹⁴ "And therefore I have sworn to the house of Eli that the iniquity of Eli's house shall not be atoned for by sacrifice or offering forever." ¹⁵ So Samuel lay down until morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel was afraid to tell Eli the vision.¹⁶ Then Eli called Samuel and said, "Samuel, my son!" And he answered, "Here I am."¹⁷ And he said, "What is the word that the LORD spoke to you? Please do not hide it from me. God do so to you, and more also, if you hide anything from me of all the things that He said to you." ¹⁸ Then Samuel told him everything, and hid nothing from him. And he said, "It is the LORD. Let Him do what seems good to Him." ¹⁹ So Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground.²⁰ And all Israel from Dan to Beersheba knew that Samuel had been established as a prophet of the LORD. ²¹ Then the LORD appeared again in Shiloh. For

the LORD revealed Himself to Samuel in Shiloh by the word of the LORD.







The peace of the Lord be with you always!






THE DISTRIBUTION
