

THE WORD

Isaiah 45:1-7 "Thus says the LORD to His anointed, To Cyrus, whose right hand I have held-- To subdue nations before him And loose the armor of kings, To open before him the double doors, So that the gates will not be shut: ² 'I will go before you And make the crooked places straight; I will break in pieces the gates of bronze And cut the bars of iron. ³ I will give you the treasures of darkness And hidden riches of secret places, That you may know

that I, the LORD, Who call *you* by your name, *Am* the God of Israel. ⁴ For Jacob My servant's sake, And Israel My elect, I have even called you by your name; I have named you, though you have not known Me. ⁵ I *am* the LORD, and *there is* no other; *There is* no God besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me, ⁶ That they may know from the rising of the sun to its setting That *there is* none besides Me. I *am* the LORD, and *there is* no other; ⁷ I form the light and create darkness, I make peace and create calamity; I, the LORD, do all these *things*.'

Matthew 22:15-22 ¹⁵ Then the Pharisees went and plotted how they might entangle Him in *His* talk. ¹⁶ And they sent to Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, "Teacher, we know that You are true, and teach the way of God in truth; nor do You care about anyone, for You do not regard the person of men. ¹⁷ "Tell us, therefore, what do You think? Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?" ¹⁸ But Jesus perceived their wickedness, and said, "Why do you test Me, *you* hypocrites? ¹⁹ "Show Me the tax money." So they brought Him a denarius. ²⁰ And He said to them,

"Whose image and inscription *is* this?" ²¹ They said to Him, "Caesar's." And He said to them, "Render therefore to Caesar the things that are Caesar's, and to God the things that are God's." ²² When they had heard *these words*, they marveled, and left Him and went their way.


THE APOSTLES' CREED


I believe in God, the Father almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.
