


p In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.






THE WORD

Genesis 3:8-15 ⁸ And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden. ⁹ Then the LORD God called to Adam and said to him, "Where are you?" ¹⁰ So he said, "I heard Your voice in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; and I hid myself." ¹¹ And He said, "Who told you that you were naked? Have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you that you should not eat?" ¹² Then the man said, "The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate." ¹³ And the LORD God said to the woman, "What *is* this you have done?" The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate." ¹⁴ So the LORD God said to the serpent: "Because you have done this, You are cursed more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you shall go, And you shall eat dust All the days of your life. ¹⁵ And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel."

2 Corinthians 4:13-5:1 ¹³ And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke¹," we also believe and therefore speak, ¹⁴ knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with Jesus, and will present us with you. ¹⁵ For all things are for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God. ¹⁶ Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷ For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, ¹⁸ while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal. ⁵¹ For we know that if our earthly house, this tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

p Blessed are they who hear the Word of God and keep it!



ATHANASIAN CREED - PART THREE

Note: In this context the word catholic means universal. Thus when we talk about the catholic faith we mean the one and only true faith which God has given to us in His word.

- p But it is also necessary for everlasting salvation that one faithfully believe the incarnation of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- c Therefore, it is the right faith that we believe and confess that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is at the same time both God and man.

- p He is God, begotten from the substance of the Father before all ages; and He is man, born from the substance of His mother in this age:
- c perfect God and perfect man, composed of a rational soul and human flesh;
- p equal to the Father with respect to His divinity, less than the Father with respect to His humanity.
- c Although He is God and man, He is not two, but one Christ:
- p one, however, not by the conversion of the divinity into flesh but by the assumption of the humanity into God;
- c one altogether, not by confusion of substance, but by unity of person.
- p For as the rational soul and flesh is one man, so God and man is one Christ,
- c who suffered for our salvation, descended into hell, rose again from the dead, ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father, from whence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

- p At His coming all people will rise again with their bodies and give an account concerning their own deeds.
- c And those who have done good will enter into eternal life, and those who have done evil into eternal fire. Amen

#342 Chief of Sinners Though I Be

SERMON

Mark 3:20-30 ²⁰ Then the multitude came together again, so that they could not so much as eat bread. ²¹ But when His own people heard *about this*, they went out to lay hold of Him, for they said, "He is out of His mind." ²² And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, "He has Beel-zebub," and, "By the ruler of the demons He casts out demons." ²³ So He called them to *Himself* and said to them in parables: "How can Satan cast out Satan? ²⁴ "If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵

stand. ²⁶ "And if Satan has risen up against himself, and is divided, he cannot stand, but has an end. ²⁷ "No one can enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man. And then he will plunder his house. ²⁸ "Assuredly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they may utter; ²⁹ "but he who blasphemes against the Holy Spirit never has forgiveness, but is subject to eternal condemnation "-- ³⁰ because they said, "He has an unclean spirit."

GOD'S MERCY DOESN'T BREAK

God's mercy stretches a long way. In fact, it never ends. His patience never runs out. However, those who reject his mercy have no hope. Don't reject God's mercy but trust in his forgiveness.
