C Have mercy on me, O God, according to your steadfast love;

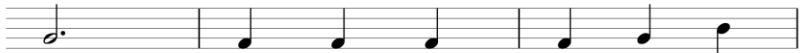
Morning Devotion - Building On Christ

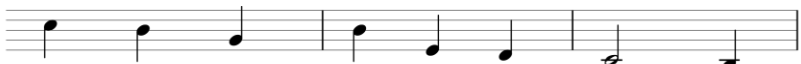
