Psalm 32:6-11

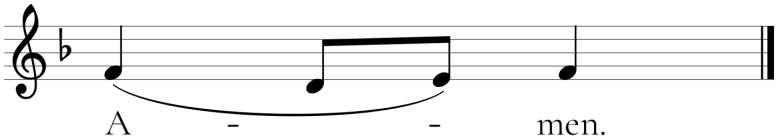

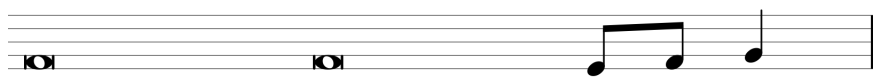

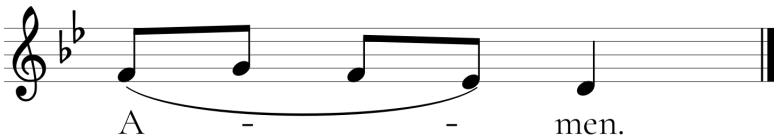
